Capacity:

The Earl Arts Centre is licensed to hold 260 people, (including staff, performers & crew).

The seating plan is for 186 seats. Seating is theatre style seating. See attached drawings for seating. Contact the venue for full details.

Performance Area:

The Earl is a space 20 metres by 13 metres.

Performance area 9.6m wide x 9.7m deep approx

Stage surface flat wooden floor mounted on resilient pads. Stage surface painted. Standard colour is with Dulux X10 Low sheen black.

The Stage is NOT to be painted by Hirers.

There are NO flies.

All theatre walls are black painted concrete block and 50 percent is covered with black curtains on continuous tracking.

Note: All electrical appliances and power leads should be tested tagged with current inspection and due date, prior to being brought onto the premises.

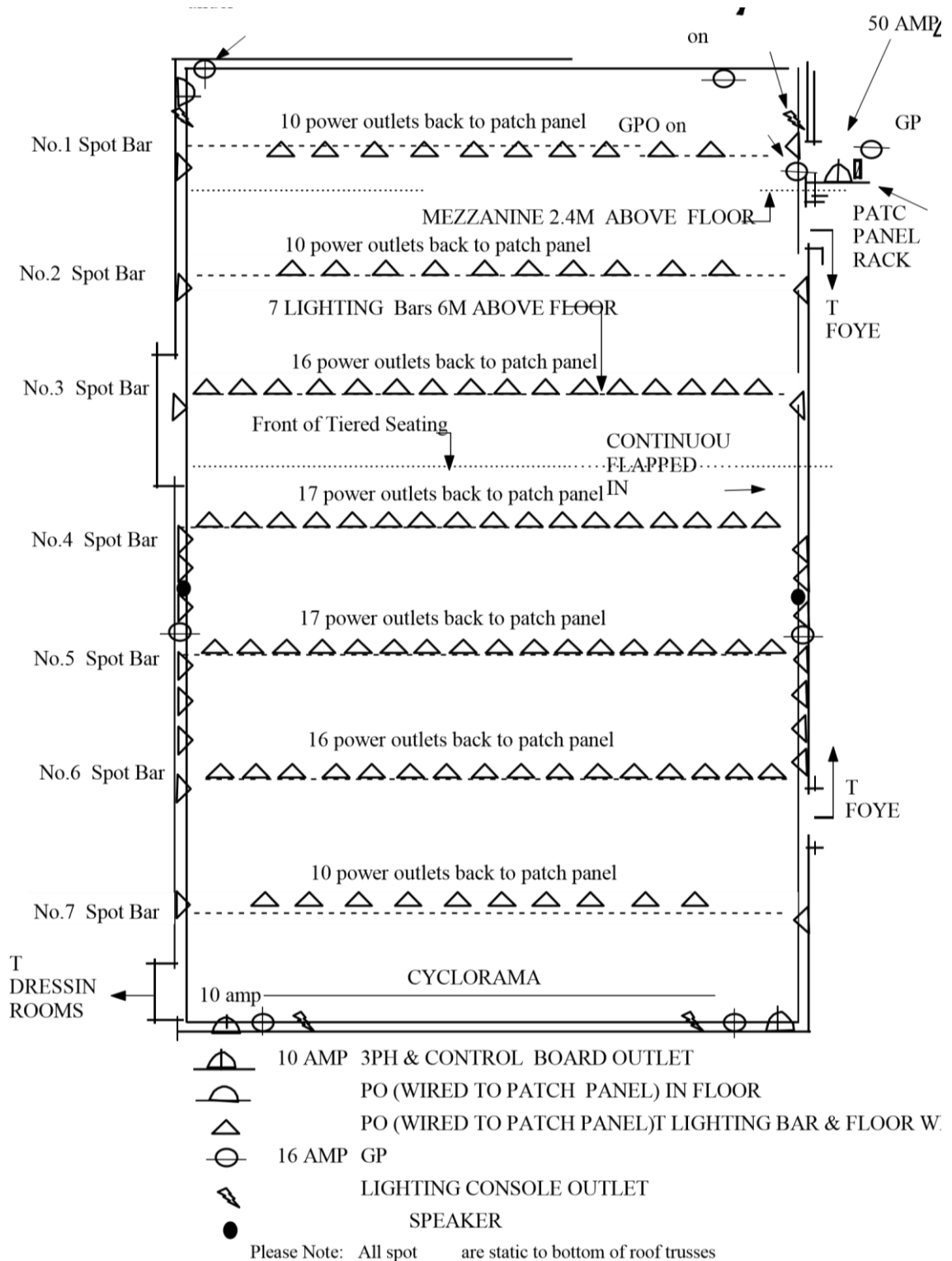

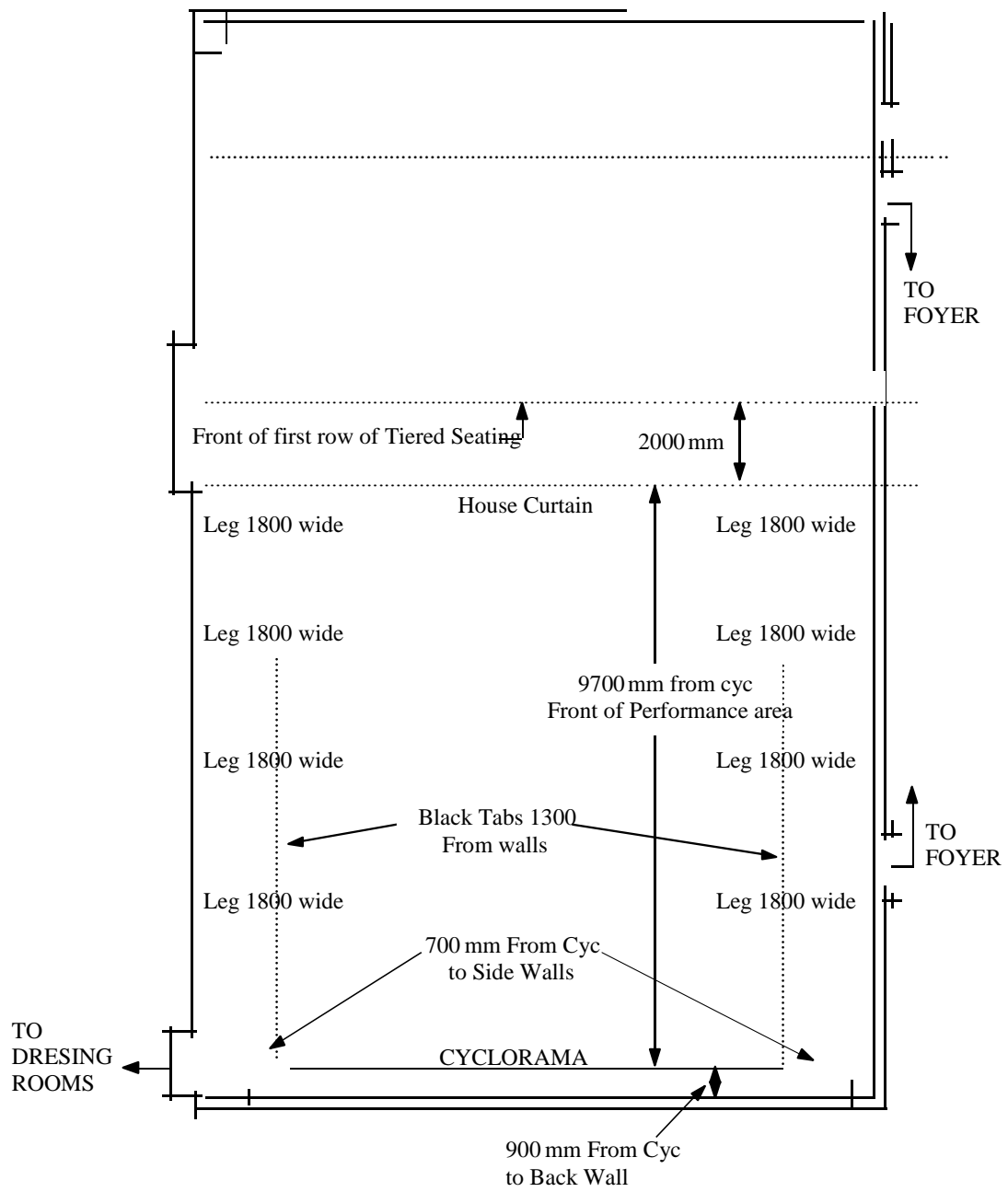
Any scenery, props, masking, Costumes etc must be rendered non flammable to the approval of Princess Theatre Management.

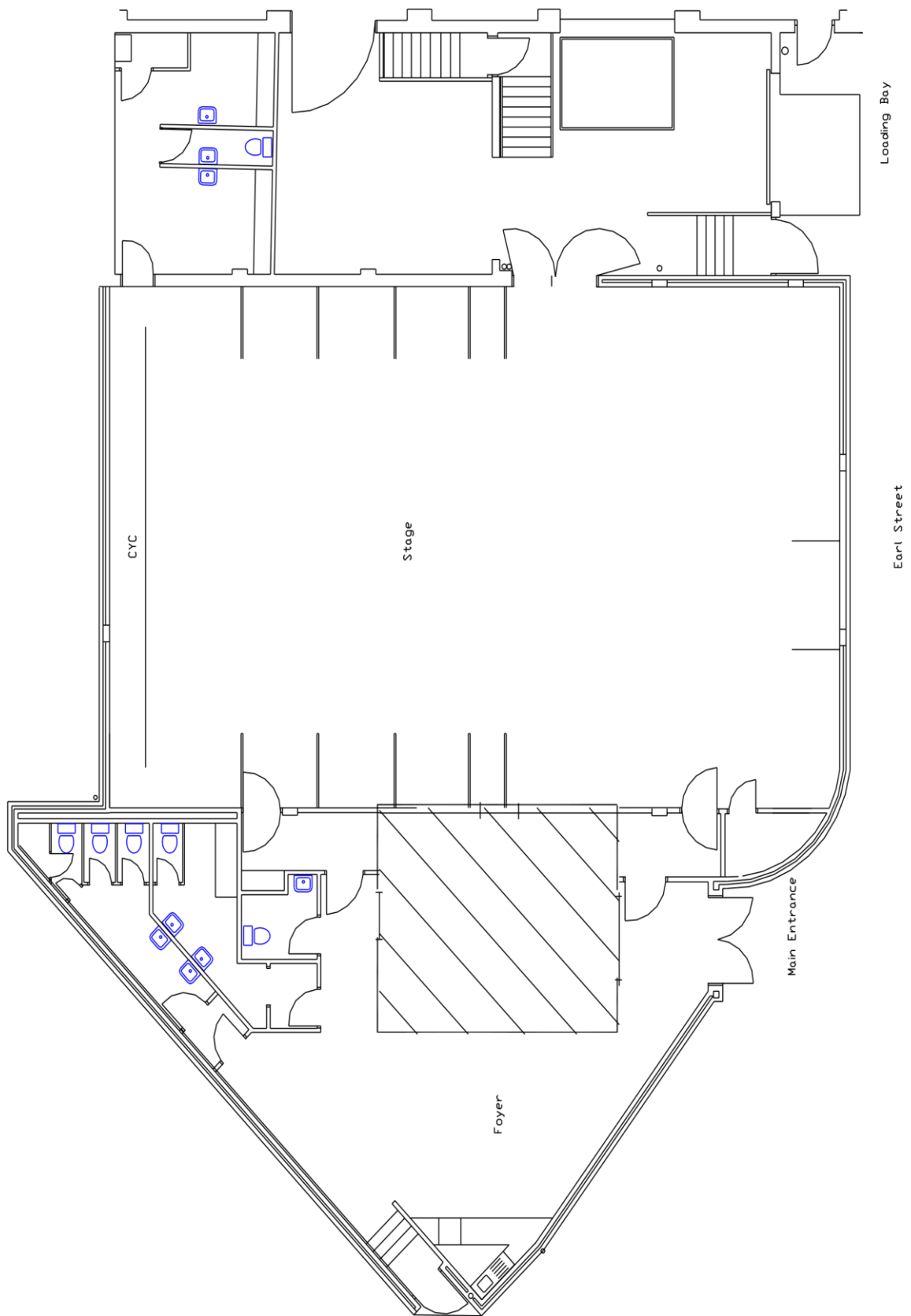

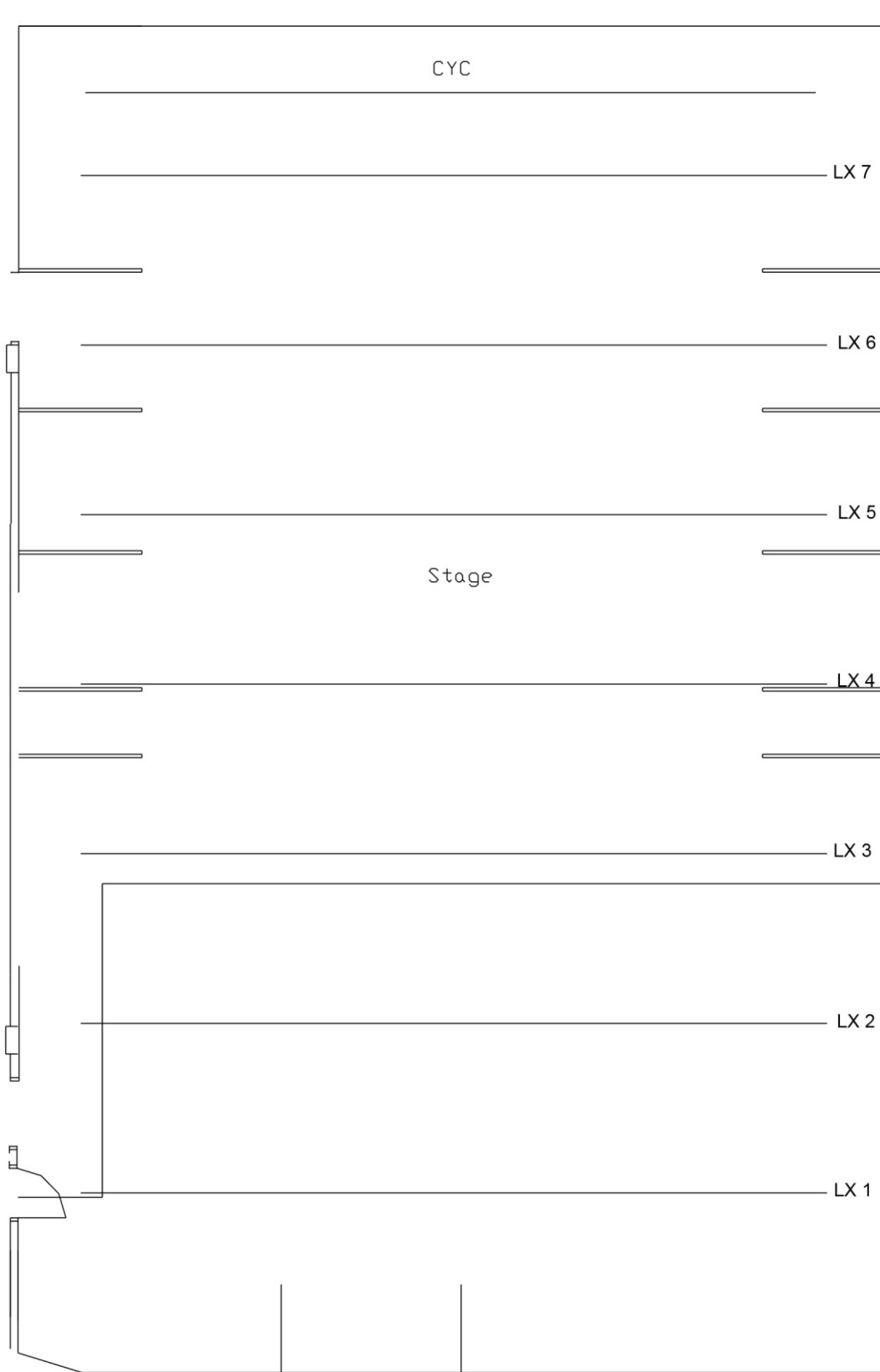

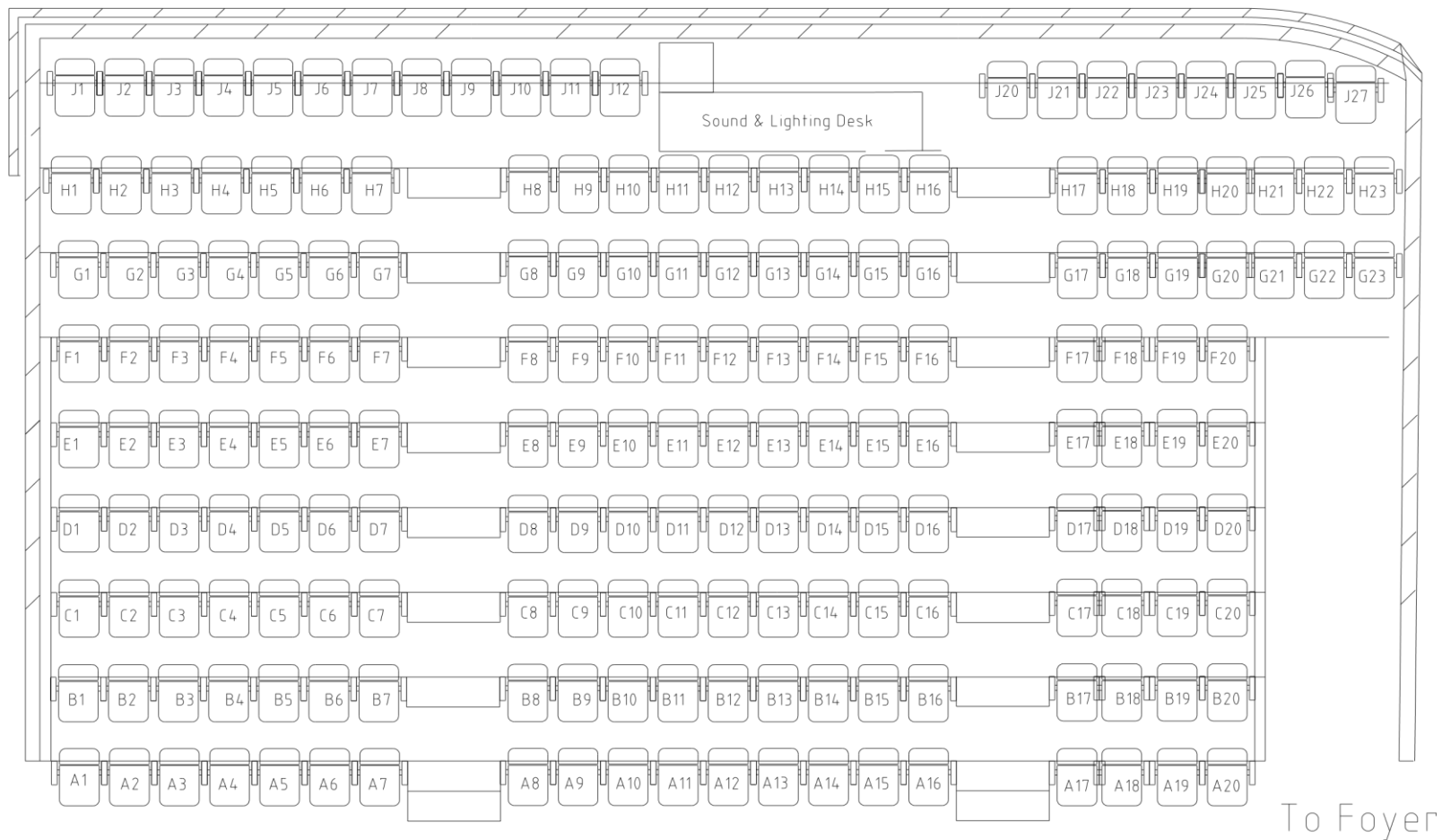
